



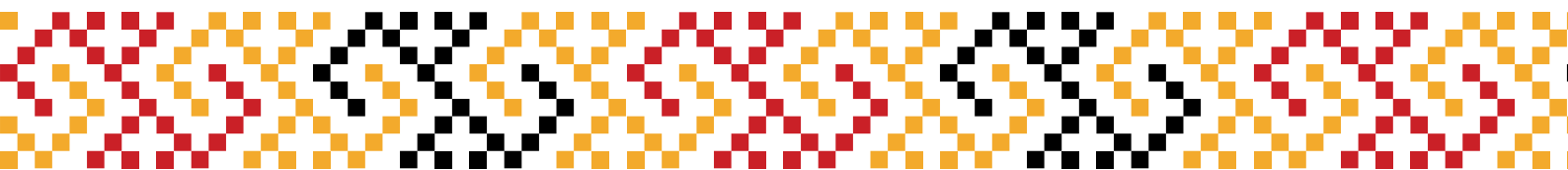

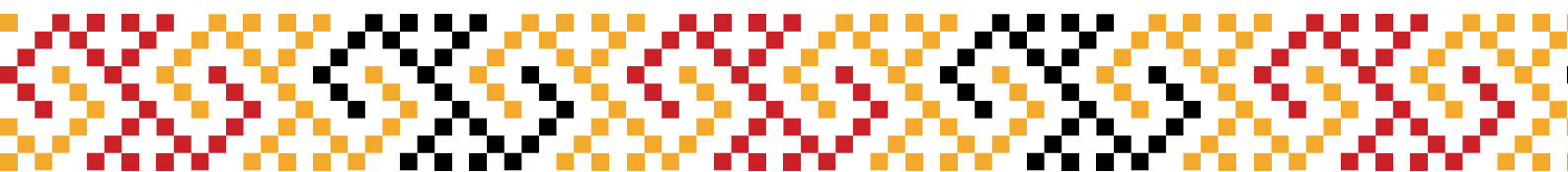
ABOUT US

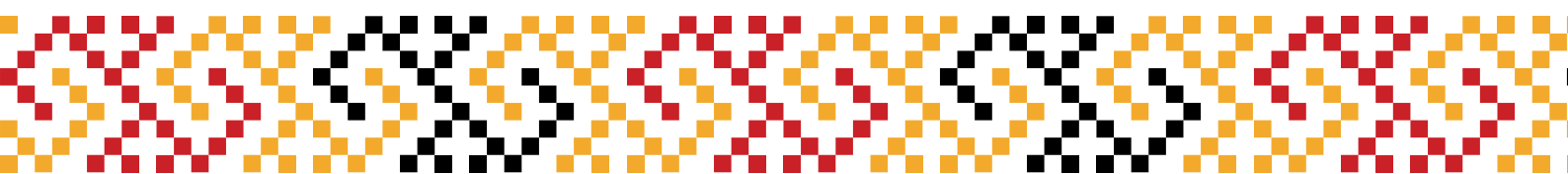




ABOUT US

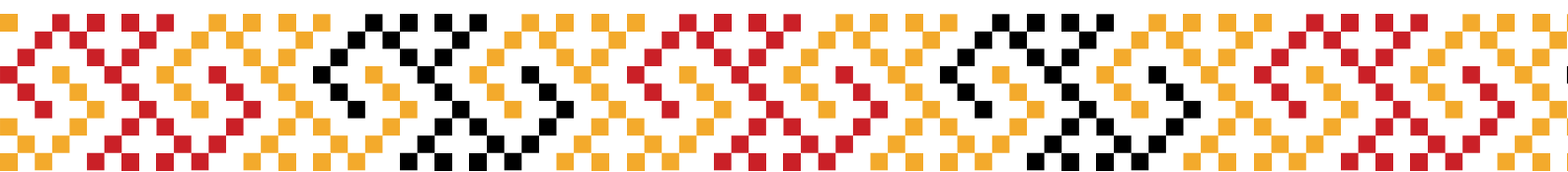
VISION

MISSION

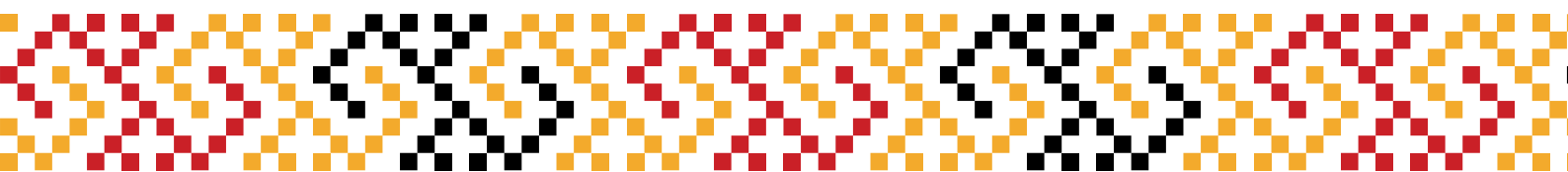

OUR VALUES

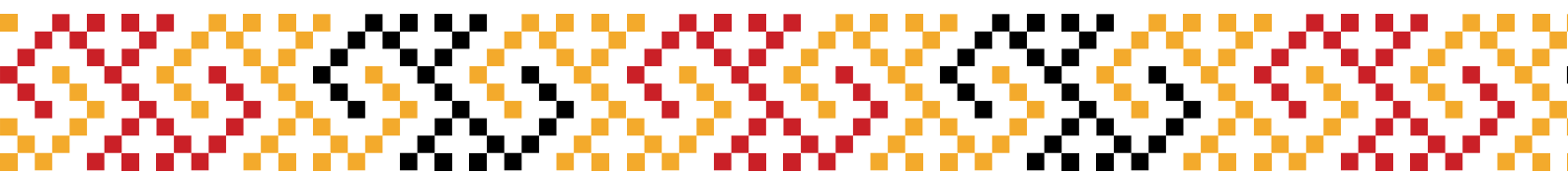

- To serve as a cohesive body that binds the industry to achieve its vision.

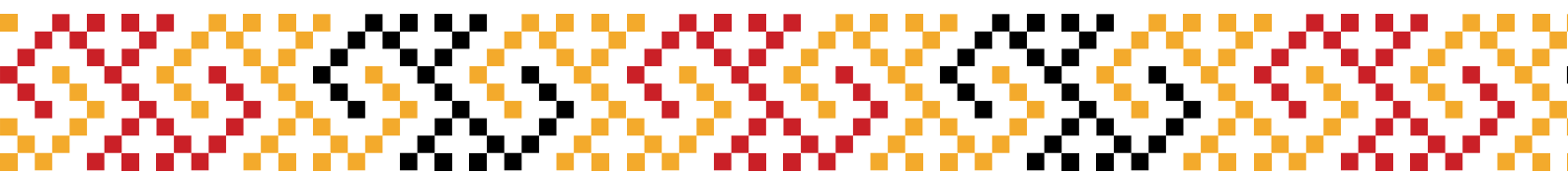
